



Rule 10 Assurance Statement: Frequently Asked Questions

Question: What is a Rule 10 Assurance Statement? Why is it important?

Answer: This statement is used to affirm School District compliance with the accreditation requirements of Rule 10.

Question: What is Rule 10?

Answer: Rule 10 refers to Regulations and Procedures for the Accreditation of Schools.

Question: How often is the Rule 10 Assurance Statement required to be submitted?

Answer: Submission of the statement is required once annually. Public districts submit the statement via an online process in the NDE Portal, and non-public districts submit a paper copy to the Office of Accreditation, Accountability, and Program Approval.

Question: Who needs to complete the Rule 10 Assurance Statement?

Answer: The School District Superintendent needs to complete the statement.

Question: How do you fill out the Rule 10 Assurance Statement?

Answer: The instructions for completing the statement are found on the form itself. The superintendent will mark all areas of compliance or non-compliance in the checkboxes provided.
